Start

- Direction
- Intention

mode of standing

- •Straighten and align the head, back, legs and feet
- •Raise hands palms facing forward, fingers not wide open nor closed entirely until the tips of thumbs are in line with earlobes
- •When tips are in line with earlobes say "ALLAHU AKBAR"
- •The gaze should be focussed towards the place where the nose/forehead will be placed in prostration.

standing & saying Allahu Akbar

- To stand is compulsory, unless one has a valid excuse or ......
  - "Allahu Akbar" should be pronounced and uttered to the extent that one may hear oneself.

Tying the hands

- •Simultaneously with saying "ALLAHU AKBAR" lower the hands whilst placing the palm of the R/hand on the back of the palm of the left hand.
- •circle the wrist of the L/hand with little (pinky) finger and thumb.
- •The remaining 3 fingers will be placed on the back of the forearm
- •Place hands below the navel

Recitals

- Recite Thanaa. (SUBHANAKALLAHUMMA WA BIHAMDIKA WA TABAARAKASMUKA WA TA'ALAA JADDUKA WA LAA ILAAHA GHAYRUK)
- Read A'UTHU BILLAHI MINASH SHAYTAWNIR RAJEEM
- Recite BISMILLAHIR RAHMAANIR RAHEEM

Reading a portion of the

Qur'an

- Recite Suratul Fatihah
- •Recite a Surah
- •\*\* Must be minimum of 3 short consecutive verses or 1 long verse which is equal to 3 short verses.
- •\*\*\*if one doesnt know any portion of the Quran one may recite "ALLAHU AKBAR" or "SUBHAANALLAH" three times
- •\*\*\*\* If behind the Imam then no need to read as his recitation suffices for you.

Ruku' (bowing)

- RUKU'
- bend down into a bowing postion so that at the least the fingers cover the knees.
- Try and straighten the back . Head must be kept in line with back.
- Try and keep legs and hands straight if possible
- fingers should be open and gripping the knees.
- gaze should be on the feet

= those factors which are compulsory
