1. Contrary to other nights where the last third of the night has special blessings and Allah descends to the lowest Heaven during this section of the night, on the night of Bara'at the special rain of mercy and forgiveness of Allah Ta'ala begins to shower down right from the beginning of the night and continues until dawn.
2. The sins of countless people are pardoned. As already mentioned, Allah Ta'ala's descension during this night to the lowest Heaven occurs from the very beginning, unlike other nights. Furthermore, the number of

The month of Ramadhan brings with it all its blessings and barakaat. Amongst its blessing is the nocturnal prayer called Taraweeh. In this prayer the entire Qur'an is completed within the 29/30 nights of Ramadhan. This prayer is an Emphasised Sunnah *Sunnah Mu'akkadah*.

This year (2021/1442) we envisage to have 4 venues for Taraweeh which will be managed by Central Masjid Rochdale. This will help in reducing over-crowding and maintaining safety measures related to gatherings. However, more importantly it will help in creating an atmosphere of Qur'an during the month of Ramadhan, a wonder and phenomenon which is witnessed throughout the world.

Through the blessings of the Qur'an we pray that Allah Ta'ala will uplift this pandemic from upon us. *Aameen*

The venues planned for Taraweeh are as follows:

4. Ashfield Road Education Centre, 235 Ashfield Road, Rochdale	27th Night of Ramadhan

In addition, Ramadhan is the month of spending on others. Rasulullah (*Sallallahu alayhi wasallam*) was the most generous of all the people, and he used to become even more generous in Ramadan when the angel Jibrael alayhis salam met him. He would meet him every night during Ramadan to revise the Qur'an with him. Rasulullah then used to be more generous than the fast wind.' [Bukhari]
