The Noble Prophet, Sall-Allahu alayhi wa sallam, has said: "The best fasts after the fasts of Ramadhan are those of the month of Muharram". Although the fasts of Muharram are not obligatory, yet one who fasts in these days is entitled to a great reward by Allah (SWT).

It is reported from Ibnu Abbaas (Radhiallahu Anhuma) that Rasulullah (Sallallahu Alaihi Wasallam) said: "The one who observes the fast of the day of Arafah two years of his sins will be forgiven and the one who fasts during the month of Muharram, for each day he fasts he will receive the reward of fasting for an entire month." It is reported from Abu Qataadah (Radhiallahu Anhu) that Rasulullah (Sallallahu Alaihi Wasallam) said: "On account of observing the fast of Aashura, I have hope that Allah Ta'aala will expiate the sins of the past year." (Ibnu Maajah 1/124, Saheeh Muslim 1/368)
