Sayyiduna Bara ibn 'Azib رضي الله عنه reports that Nabi صلى الله عليه وسلم said: "... When a Believer is leaving this world and heading for the Hereafter, angels with white radiant faces descend, as though their faces are [as bright] as the sun, they have shrouds of Jannah and [fragrance] from Jannah. They sit from him as far as his eyes can see. Then the angel of death comes, sits by his head and says, 'O pure soul! Come out to the forgiveness and happiness of Allah...'
