In a hadith, Rasoolullah ﷺ addressed those performing Hajj and Umrah - and today you are his addressees: Sayyidna Abu Hurairah Radi-Allahu anhu narrates that Rasoolullah ﷺ said: (translation) The travelers of Hajj and Umrah are Allah's special guests; if they supplicate to Allah, He accepts their supplications and if they seek forgiveness, He forgives them. *(Hisn-e-Hasin, Ibn Majah and Nasai)*
